PLENARY SESSION

Welcome & Introduction

Bruce Rodan, Associate Director for Science for the Office of Research and Development | *U.S. Environmental Protection Agency*

Dr. Bruce Rodan welcomed everyone to the fourth day of the U.S. EPA's International Decontamination Research and Development Conference. Dr. Rodan noted he has seen first-hand the importance of the research presented in the sessions, which enables society to respond to and recover from chemical, biological, and radiological events, as well as natural disasters.
