Exposure to diesel exhaust can lead to serious health conditions like **asthma**.



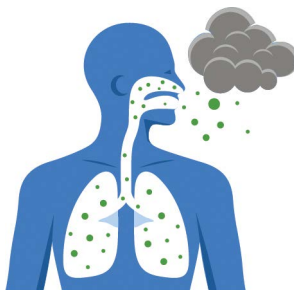
Older diesel equipment emits **harmful pollutants** including air toxics.
